Re: Letter of Status, Kingston Valves Instrumentation Calibration

Storm Manufacturing Group as a matter of course does not issue a Certification of Calibration for individual valves. Pressure relief valves are not themselves 'calibrated.' All Kingston Safety Valves are manufactured under a quality control system approved by the National Board of Boiler Inspectors and Pressure Vessel Inspectors. The instrumentation required to test Kingston Safety Valves are subject to periodic calibration testing to ensure both quality and safety.

This letter of status has been generated to inform our customers that, as of the date listed above, all instrumentation used in the manufacture and test of Kingston Safety Valves falls within calibration expiry periods. Third party calibration is performed under standards traceable to contractor's individual NIST (National Institute of Standards and Technology) number using calibration systems conforming to ISO, MILSTD, ANSI & 10CFR.
